- Policy for gas networks and markets to allow widespread blending, and later sole use of hydrogen.

	deliverable, timing, not just outcomes). DvP will take back	
	to ENA and FFCRC.	
Other matters: enablers,	Concern raised about lack of clarity from NHS	
challenges	implementation team. FS outlined role of new H2 under 2	
	group to get work done and share information, and this	
	group can input to that work.	
Engagement with others	Discussion on which govt we should advocate take the lead	
	for energy reform/gas blending under NHS. General	
	consensus that NSW was priority because has a blending	
	target, then SA, then Victoria.	
	JC-H raised issue with AER consideration of hydrogen. FS	
	asked for list of issues like this so we can understand policy	
	matters we can address under this WG and link in with	
	AEMO, AER and AEMC.	
Next steps	1. Members to send FS their lists of policy issues under this	
	working group.	
	2. MK to introduce FS to Tim Stock, who is leading NSW H2	
	work.	
	3. FS to address gas reform leadership with NSW.	
	4. DvP to follow up information sharing with ENA and	
	FFCRC and come back to FS.
