## Systems: Big picture/structural matters

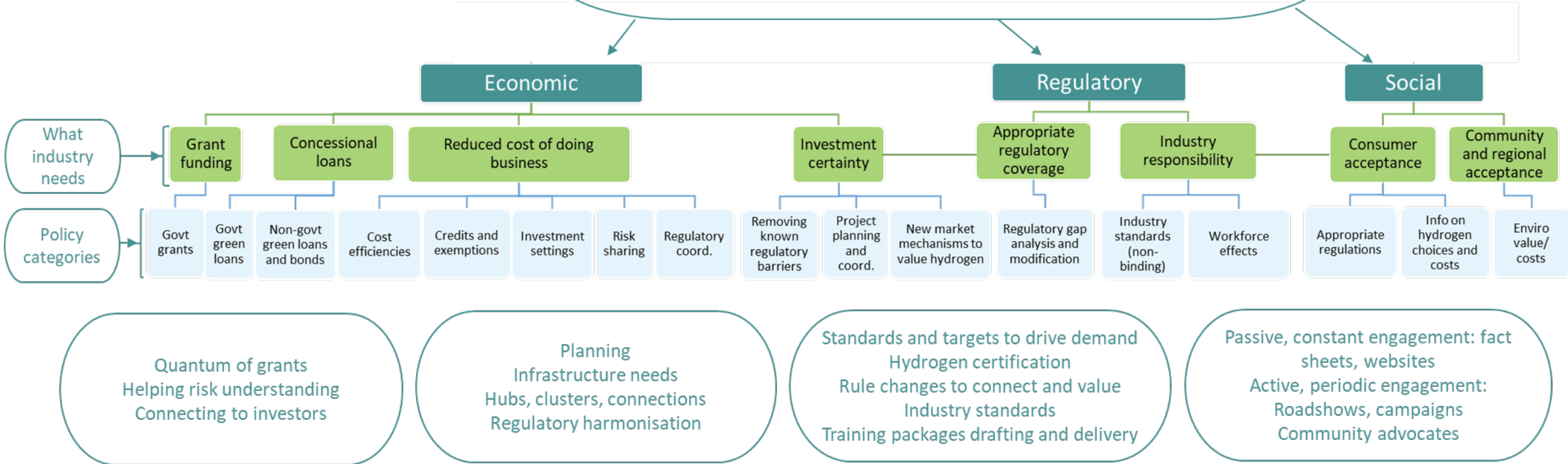
Necessary conditions for transformation – e.g. policy to value carbon, fitness of institutional structures and support

Many of the issues can be covered by multiple systems but this shows the fundamental system starting point from an industry perspective
